This program serves SSA disability recipients who have insecure housing, behavioral health issues, substance abuse, and/or developmental disabilities.

- Help individuals meet basic needs and avoid homelessness, malnutrition, and other risks associated with disability
- Assist clients respectfully and with compassion
- Prevent exploitation by family members or acquaintances
- Provide an alternative way for loving family members to manage a relative's care
- Link clients to benefits such as food stamps and Medicaid
- Encourage client participation in budgeting and managing bills for a greater sense of empowerment



Voluntary Payee Service Also Available

Even if you or your loved one is not on SSA disability, Financial Pathways can help manage monthly bills and expenses. For a modest fee through a Voluntary Payee arrangement, we can use our secure, confidential system to receive and track income and pay monthly bills. For someone in a care facility, or for a disabled person with aging parents, this may be the right solution.
