

## **Award Criteria**

- Those who act in the spirit of a financial health first responder
- Those who make it a part of their daily job to support the public and have "wins" for regular, everyday people
- Must have been employed in a role where they were serving the public as a "financial health first responder" for more than 1 (one) year
- Demonstrates continued "going above and beyond" support or service
- Financial consultant or counselor at nonprofits, organizations, companies, financial institutions, etc.
- Work in the Piedmont area
- Be nominated by someone who can give direct information about their role and service – colleague, supervisor, recipient of their service, etc.
- If not being nominated by supervisor, their supervisor must sign off on the nomination
